

Frank Bratt Memorial Scholarship Application

The NYS Conservation District Employees Association holds a scholarship program for District employees, their immediate families and New York State Soil and Water Conservation Committee staff who are interested in furthering their education. This scholarship can encompass a broad range of topics, with emphasis placed upon conservation related topics and subjects related to District function. The training can be in almost any form, such as college courses, seminars, workshops, or meetings.

Scholarships will be awarded based upon the supposed value of the course to the applicant, to be judged by the eight NYSCDEA Division Representatives. The minimum amount of the scholarship is \$50, and the maximum is \$500. Successful applicants will be notified within one week following the next regularly scheduled Executive Board meeting that follows the application deadline. Scholarship recipients have two years from date of notification letter to successfully complete course.
