

What Can I Do to Benefit the Association?

Who Represents You in the Association?

Each state has one voting member who is selected by the District employees of that state. The voting members from each state elect the officers from nominations made at the annual meeting.

Every part-time or full-time employee of any Conservation District office in the Northeast Region is automatically a member of the Association. The Association does not charge dues to be a member.
