Certified trainer of the 4hr E&S Course:

To maintain certification to train:

- Must have CPESC or new NY ESC Certification
- Must have participated in the updated "Train the Trainer" course on March 17, 2016 at the WQS (going over revised presentation)
 - o Or sit through course led by one of the trainers before certification can be renewed
- Must instruct the course at least once per year to maintain eligibility to teach the course
- Must currently be employed by SWCD (no retirees permissible)
 - DEC staff can co-teach the course or become a certified trainer meeting above requirements additionally can only teach at a course hosted by SWCD (DEC staff cannot accept payment for training)

To become new trainer:

- Must have CPESC or new NY E&S Certification
- Must be employed by SWCD or DEC (exception for DOT & NYCDEP to provide training internally by qualified staff person)
- Must shadow current trainer by sitting in on the course
- Must teach the course with a certified presenter in attendance
- Must contact Dave Gasper (<u>david.gasper@dec.ny.gov</u>) to receive official trainer number. They
 will need the NYS DEC Train- the-Trainer form completed and submitted. In addition, they will
 need correspondence (letter or e-mail) from the certified trainer indicating that they observed
 the new trainer give the course.
- Must teach course once per year to maintain teacher certification
