NOTICE OF VACANCY DISTRICT TECHNICIAN

This position is responsible for performing a variety of technical duties related to the establishment of land and water conservation practices on public and private property. An employee in this class works closely with private contractors, District staff, and landowners to implement environmental conservation programs. Work is performed under the general supervision of the District Field Manager and Board of Directors of the Chenango County Soil and Water Conservation District. Supervision over the work of others is not a requirement of this position.

The title of District Technician is Competitive, requiring applicant to meet minimum qualifications established for the position and successfully meet civil service examination requirements. Permanent appointment will be dependent upon participation in the examination and being available from the resulting eligibility list. The examination date is anticipated for 2022.
